The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District Chancellor Search College Forums will take place, as originally scheduled for Monday, March 16, and Tuesday, March 17, 2020. We are taking every precaution to adhere to Alameda County Public Health Department and California Department of Public Health's guidelines for public gatherings.

District employees, students and community members will have three viewing options. One, viewing is still available in-person, however we will cap the number of guests per County and State health guidelines for small public gatherings. Two, guests will have the option to view the forums via live streaming with the ability to submit questions via email during the forums. Three, the forums will be recorded and we will share links to the videos, embedded with a candidate survey link, 24-72 hours after the forums conclude.
