Havik will participate in the inaugural Las Positas College Literary Arts Festival on Saturday, May 9, 2020. Held on campus at the Mertes Center for the Arts in building 4000, the festival includes a publication and awards ceremony for this year's Havik from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
