Las Positas College Announces "FastPass" Enrollment Event

(Livermore, CA) - Students interested in attending Las Positas College (LPC) in the fall will have the opportunity to fully complete their enrollment applications during a four-day event that will run from April 30 through May 3.

The LPC FastPass event will provide future students assistance with completing the college's admissions application, online orientation, financial aid application and course registration. Students will also be able to complete assessment testing in English and math, and meet with someone who can assist them in setting up their educational plan.

"Under normal circumstances the entire registration process can take two to three weeks," said Mike Alvarez, LPC outreach specialist. "The FastPass event was created to help expedite the process, which potential students can complete in one to two days."

Alvarez said that students who submit their application for admission and complete the online orientation could potentially complete the assessment testing, program planning and registration process in one day. Students who want to complete all five steps - application, orientation, testing, planning and registration onsite can finish the process in two days or spread everything out over the course of the four-day event.

LPC's FastPass event will be located in the Student Services and Administration office in Building 1600 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. between Monday, April 30 and Thursday, May 3. Sessions are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
