"The night will feature re-arrangements of typical jazz standards written by masters of jazz,"

said Mario Silva. "The re-arrangements were done by the students in the class. I have brought an element of the Latin tinge to the class so that will also be conveyed. The class is excited to present this music they've been working diligently on and look forward to seeing everyone there."

In addition, one of the pieces will pay homage to the late Roy Hargrove, a jazz trumpeter who died in November 2018. Hargrove won Grammy Awards for Best Latin Jazz Album in 1998 and Best Jazz Instrumental Album in 2002, and primarily played in the hard bop-style of jazz.
