New Trustee Appointed to the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District Board of Trustees



(Dublin, CA) - The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District Board of Trustees has appointed a new member from Trustee Area 5, which includes the cities of Dublin, Pleasanton and Sunol.

Mr. Tim Sbranti of Dublin will replace Mr. Carlo Vecchiarelli, who retired in February, as an appointed member of the Board until the next regularly scheduled election for governing board members in November 2020.

The Board of Trustees is responsible for the governance of Chabot College in Hayward and Las Positas College in Livermore.

Mr. Sbranti has devoted his life to public service both as an educator and elected official. He is an educator with the Dublin Unified School District, a statewide leader in education, and currently serves on the Board of the California Collaborative for Educational Excellence (CCEE). As Mayor for the City of Dublin (2008-2014), he helped guide the City through some of its most transformative years. He served as the District Director/Deputy Chief of Staff for Congressman Eric Swalwell, and continues his local civic engagement as a board member on various non-profit organizations, including co-chair for the Education and Workforce Development Committee for Innovation Tri-Valley Leadership Group.

"We had six excellent candidates who are devoted to their community and we thank them for their interest in serving the District," said Edralin "Ed" Maduli, president of the Board of Trustees. "We are pleased with the selection of Mr. Sbranti. As a lifelong public servant, he has extensive experience in education, government at the local, state and federal level, knowledge of our community, and he will be a great addition to our Board and the District."

Mr. Sbranti will fulfill the responsibilities of a Trustee, including attending all board meetings and some college events, studying agendas and issues and participating fully in the governance of the District.

Mr. Sbranti was appointed following a process that included a review of applications and interviews with the current Board. Mr. Sbranti will be sworn in and begin service at the regularly scheduled board meeting, at Las Positas College, on April 16, 2019.
