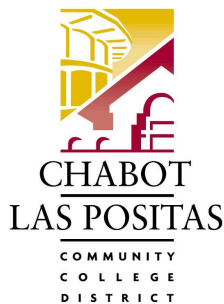

CLPCCD Board of Trustees will commence search for new Chancellor



(Dublin, CA) - The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District (CLPCCD) Board of Trustees, at their August 21, 2018 board meeting, accepted the resignation of Chancellor Jackson, effective August 22, 2018. A search for her successor will commence this fall with the goal of having a new Chancellor in place by spring 2019.

Dr. Jackson served five years in the role of Chancellor. "The Board wishes to take this opportunity to thank Dr. Jackson for her dedicated service to the District and recognize her many years of service to the community college system. We will miss her and wish her well," said Board President, Dr. Marshall Mitzman.

Dr. Susan Cota, Chancellor Emeritus and current Interim Chancellor, will conclude her term on September 14, 2018. A new interim Chancellor, Dr. Thomas Fallo, has been appointed, pending contract negotiations, to start September 17, 2018 and his term will end once a new Chancellor has been selected.

Dr. Fallo has a 45-year career in the California Community Colleges and retired as superintendent/president of El Camino College in 2016 after serving 21 years in that role. He most recently served as interim Chancellor for South Orange County Community College District. He previously worked at the Los Angeles Community College District, serving as acting and interim chancellor and vice chancellor of business services. Prior to that, he held the positions of vice chancellor of business services and vice president of administrative services at both El Camino College and Glendale Community College District.
