Once tours and orientations are complete, LPC will host a lunch and resource fair for all students and their families at the Student Services and Administration South Patio, Building 1600, where students can learn more about LPC programs and services including: Arts and Humanities, Business Health Athletics and Work Experience, California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs), Campus Safety and Security, Child Development Center, Community Education, Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE), Disabled Student Programs and Services, Extended Opportunity Programs and Services, Financial Aid and Scholarships, Las Positas College Student Government, Learning Communities, Library, STEM, Student Health and Wellness Center, Tutorial Center, Veterans Resource Center, WorkAbility III and Social Science, Library, Public Safety and Career Education.
