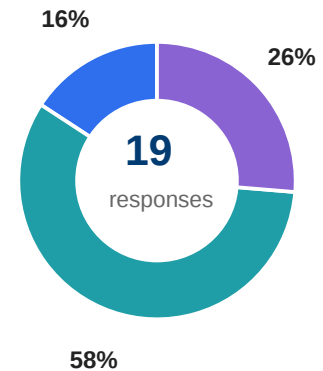


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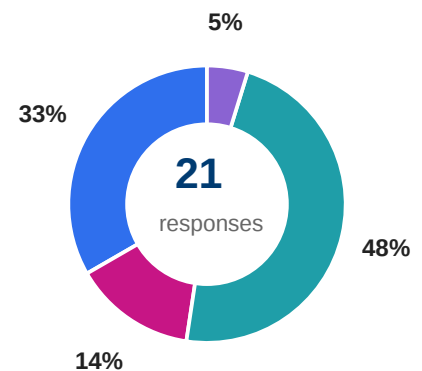
1. At which site do you work/attend class? Please check all that apply.

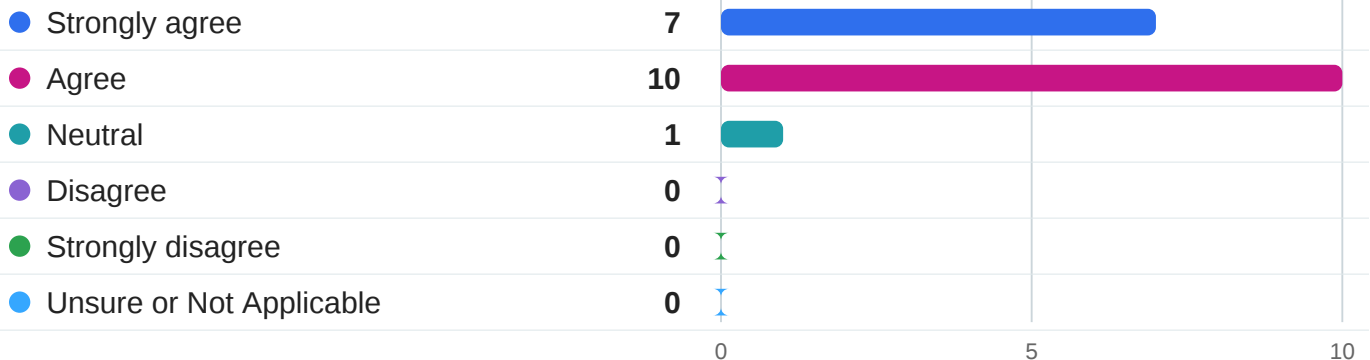


2. On which committee do you serve? Please check all that apply.

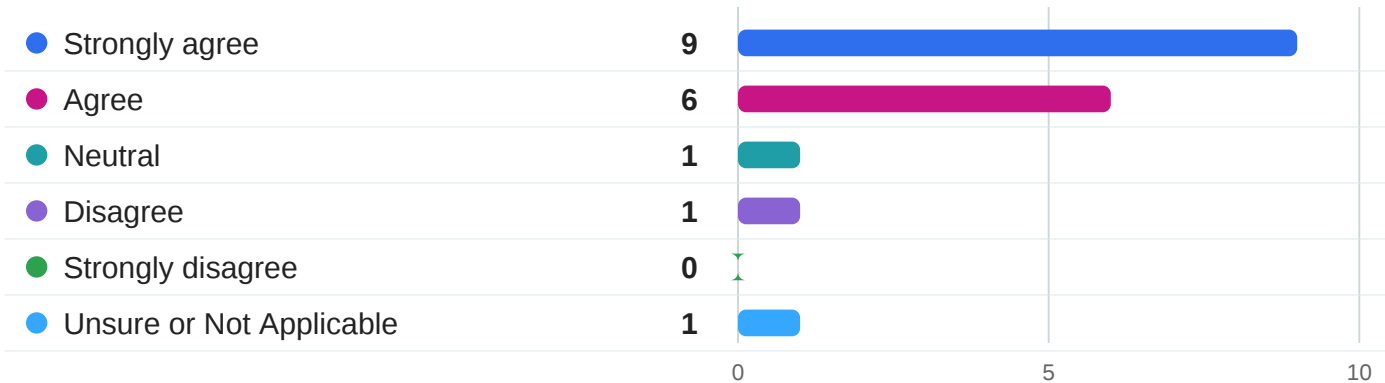
To me the committee has too many members but I understand why we have so many and the need for all groups to be represented.

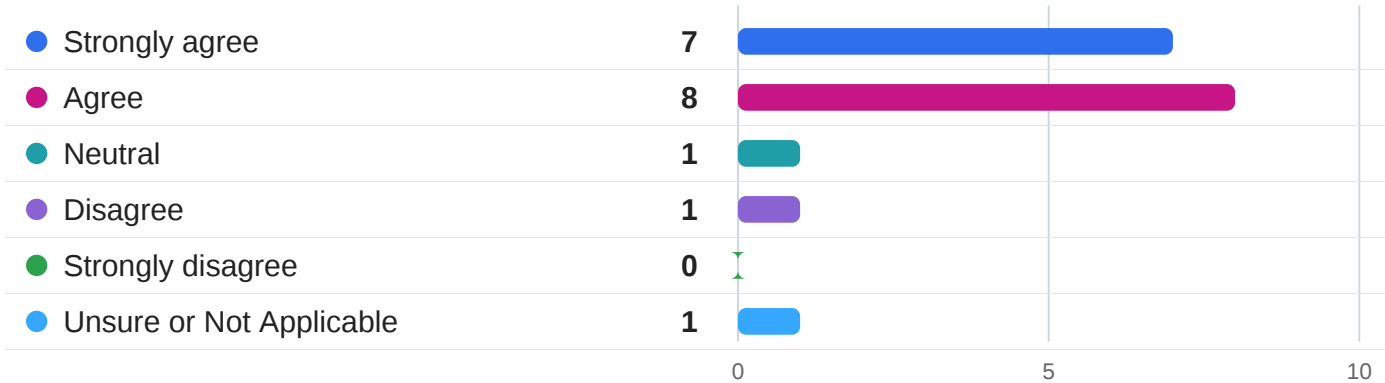

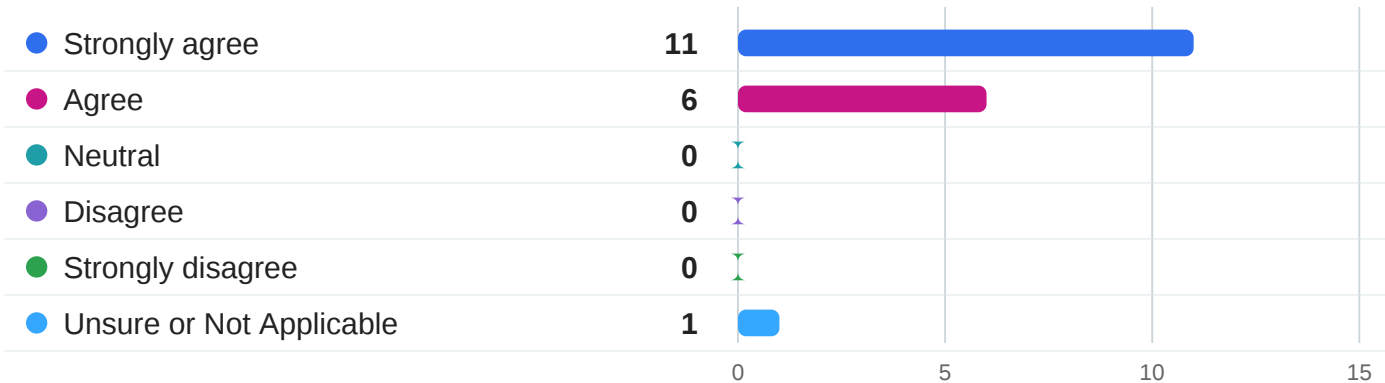
Dawn does a great job.

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17. Committee meets regularly, as scheduled.

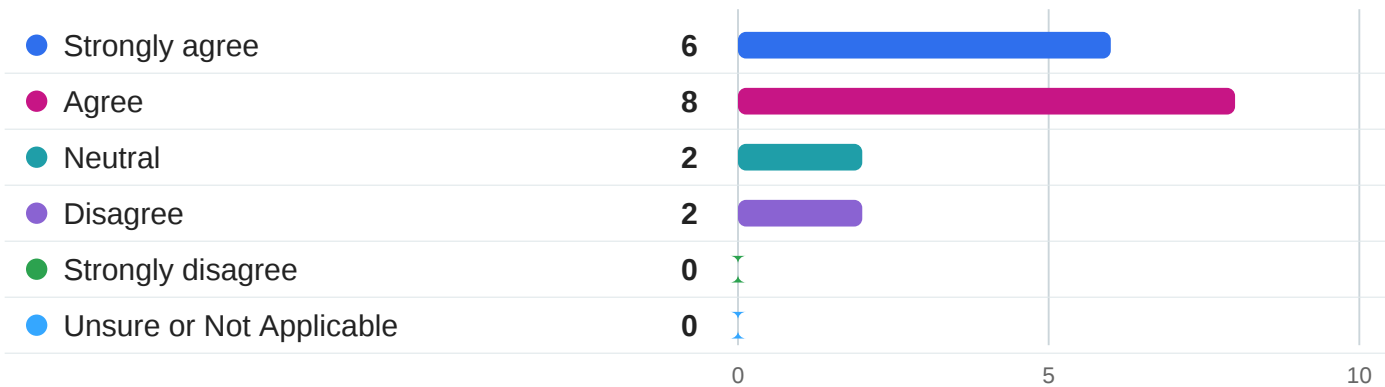

19. Minutes are taken, widely publicized and easily accessible.



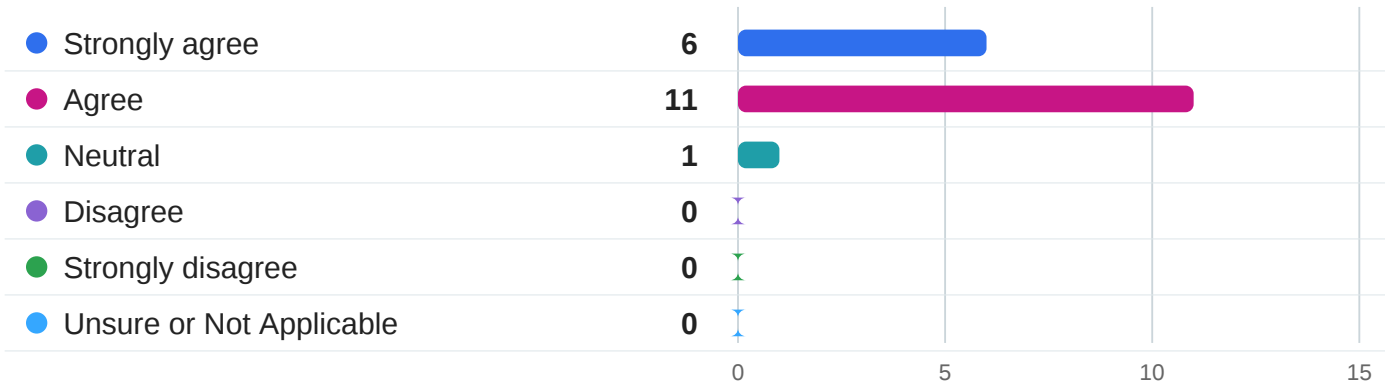

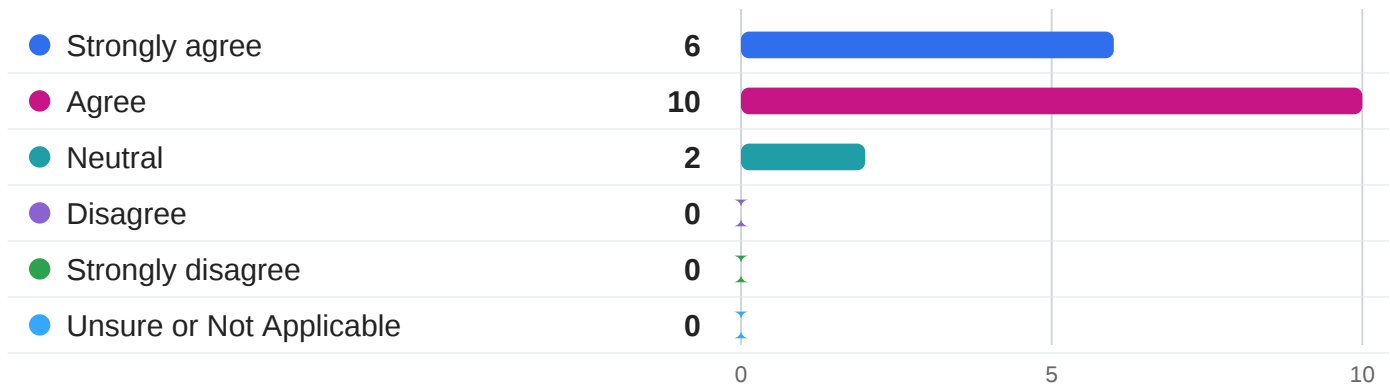
Reps. usually will serve on PBC and the relevant college committees.

Not sure of mechanism for conveying information from district to college. I do know this happens from DEMC to CEMC.

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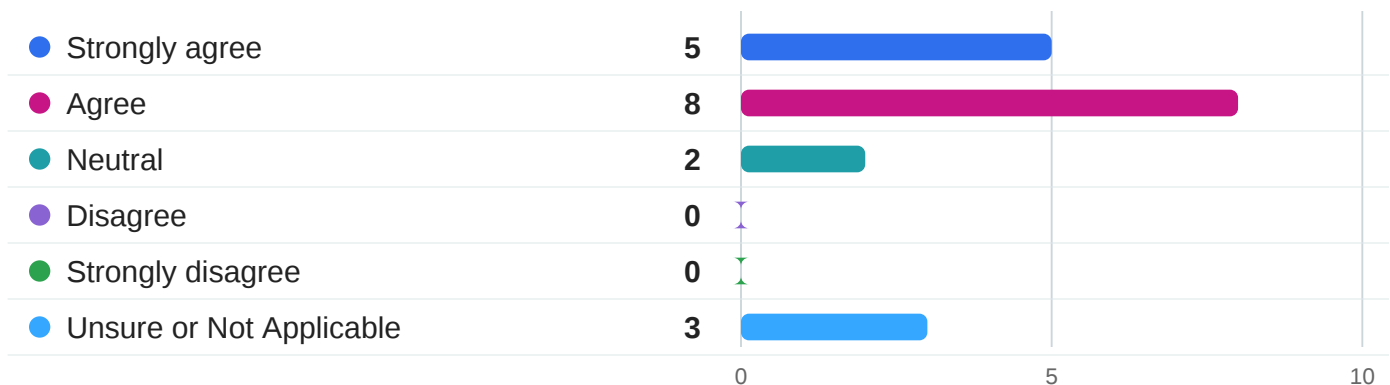
